Oaks, Birches,
Willows, Apples,
as well as 100 other
species.

Symptoms/ Damage

Moderate to
severe defoliation
of trees.

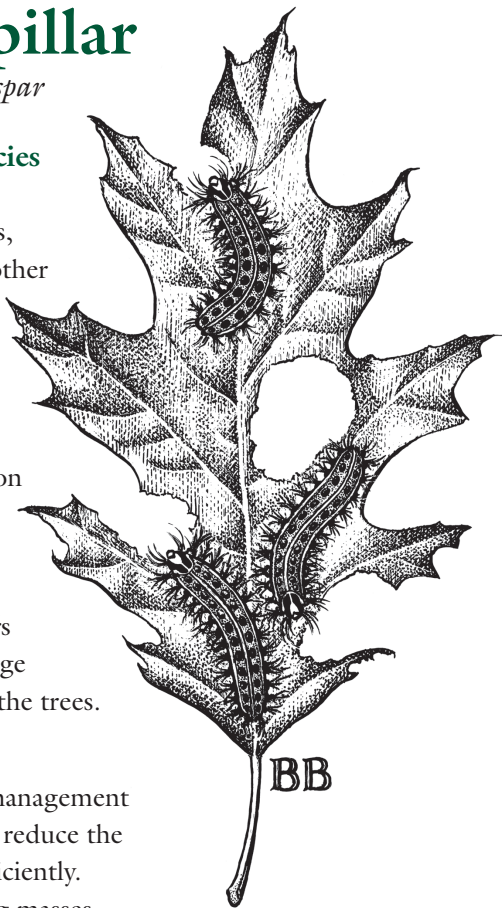
Contrary to
popular belief,
these caterpillars
do not leave large
webs (nests) in the trees.

Treatment

A simple pest management
application will reduce the
population sufficiently.
Remove tan egg masses
manually when accessible.

Treatment Timing

During the first stages of feeding – early June.
