Winter Tree Work

View Enhancement: Opening vistas in winter is ideal because leaves don't block the view potential.

Frozen Ground: Removal of large trees during the winter months when the ground is frozen minimizes damage to lawns, gardens, and the forest floor.

Pruning: Winter is an excellent time for pruning most species of trees. Dormant pruning prevents the spread of disease, helps the arborist with increased visibility in the crown of the tree, and minimizes shock to the tree because of leaf loss.

Fruit Trees: February and March are preferred times for orchard pruning.
