For pH enhancement  
*1-2 per season, anytime*

For disease resistance,  
enhanced microbial activity,  
stimulates root growth  
*1-2 per season, anytime*

#### **Maine Sea Kelp**

An organic matter soil  
enhancement  
*Spring and/or Fall*

#### **Granular Potash**

0-0-50 for hardiness, disease  
tolerance  
*Fall only*

#### **Zero Phosphate**

24-0-12 slow release  
fertilizer for use around lakes  
*1-6 per season*

#### **Corn Gluten**

Pre-emergent organic  
fertilizer 9-0-0  
*Spring only*

#### **Core Aeration**

Reduce soil compaction  
and improve air, water, and  
nutrient flow into soil  
*Spring or Fall*

#### **Overseeding**

Introduces new growth  
into existing lawn to thicken  
density  
*Spring or Fall*

#### **Tick Control**

Effectively manages tick  
populations  
*1-5 Available, May-September*
