Tree & Shrub Preservation

Pruning & Cabling: Prune to improve the health, safety and beauty of your trees or shrubs. Preserve your aesthetically valuable trees by adding strength to weak branch unions with cabling & bracing.

Natural or Traditional Insect & Disease Control: Curative or preventative treatments to suppress damaging insect or disease populations on your valuable trees and shrubs.

Tree Selection & Planting: Our Certified Arborist examines your site and recommends plantings based on your preferences (shade, wildlife attraction, or aesthetics) and location, microclimate, soil type, etc. Delivery, installation, aftercare instructions, and a planting guarantee are available.

Large Tree & Shrub Relocation: Move or install trees or shrubs up to 9" in diameter or 25ft in height.

Large Tree Nursery: Visit our Woodstock, VT nursery to select large trees for transplanting to your location.

Tree & Shrub Fertilization: 85% slow-release, zero-phosphate fertilizer with added bio-stimulants methodically applied in either the spring or fall nourishes and sustains your trees or shrubs.

Shoreline Protection Consultation: Our Certified Arborist meticulously assesses your site and makes recommendations for compliance with all regulations of the NH Comprehensive Shoreland Protection Act.

Landscape Health Assessment: Our consulting professional examines a single plant or entire groups to determine the best approach for maintaining or improving the health of your landscape.

Pre- & Post-Construction Consultation: Meet with a Certified Arborist before your construction project to assist with tree preservation planning; or for a post-construction remedial consultation plan.

Hazardous Tree Removal: Professionally trained crews and specialized equipment (crane, hand climbing, or bucket truck) safely remove very large trees in any location to minimize the risks to your property.

Stump Grinding: Eliminate any size stump with our tow behind or self-propelled stump grinder, leaving an area for you to plant a new tree, shrub, garden or lawn.

Emergency Services & Storm Damage Assistance: When storms approach our crews remain on call for your convenience, and assistance is available for all tree-related emergencies.

Arboricultural Consultation: Our Consulting Arborist provides you with expert advice, diagnosis, appraisal and evaluation of all arboricultural issues. Experienced in forensics and as an expert witness in legal cases.

Turf & Soil Care

Turf Fertilization: Enrich your turf's density, health, and color with a choice of systemic fertilizers, ranging from organic, to natural or traditional products blended with weed or crabgrass control.

Insect & Disease Control: Proven and precise methods enhance your turf's density, health, and color. Products range from high calcium lime with enzymes, to iron supplements, to grub and tick control.

Soil Amendments: Professional application of Atlantic sea kelp, organic corn gluten, or compost builds and maintains soil fertility, thereby improving your turf's density, health, and color.

Aeration & Over-seeding: Improve air circulation, reduce compaction, and thicken your existing lawn by having it aerated and/or over-seeded with a custom blend of grass seed for your location.

Forestry

Current Use Enrollment: Assistance with the NH or VT program enrollment based on developing a responsibly structured management plan for your property in exchange for reduced taxes.
