Some products work before the weed actually appears (as is the case with crabgrass control in the spring) while other products target existing weeds in a lawn, and will not harm the grass.

In either case, timing is as critical as the type of product being applied. As a general rule, many types of weeds can be reduced or actually eliminated from a lawn setting with proper timing and technique. However, there are tough weeds like violets and ground ivy that are very resistant to traditional materials which often require more action and time to control.
