## Eastern Tent Caterpillar

Malacosoma americanum

Affected Species

Cherries, Crabapples, Apples

# Environmental Conditions

Tents appear in spring as leaves unfold.

### Symptoms

Silken webs (tents)
in forked branches.
They will contain black
caterpillars with blue markings
during cool wet weather. The
caterpillars travel from the tent
to the leaves to feed on warm sunny days.

#### Treatment

Remove tents by hand, when accessible, on cool rainy days or treat with an insecticide. Do not burn them in the tree.

### **Treatment Timing**

Late April – early June
