The Landscape/Garden Division Manager must identify opportunities for improvements in all aspects of design, installation, greenhouse management, client relations, production, quality, service, safety and communicate said opportunities for improvement to the VP of Sales and VP of Operations.

- Provide timely, accurate, competitive pricing on all client proposal requests,
 while striving to maintain maximum profit margin
- Maintain contact with all landscape and garden division clients to ensure WOW client satisfaction
- Aid in the development and implementation of marketing plans as needed
- Create and close work orders in a timely manner
- Facilitate and contribute to performance evaluations to build more effective communications, to understand training and development needs, and to provide insight for the improvement of employee work quality and performance
- Set example in areas of personal character, commitment, organization and communication, and work habits
- Job scheduling, job briefings with crew and job completion follow-up
- Daily production and supervision of assigned employees
- Employee on-the-job training and documentation
- Ensure that each crew member is working efficiently, adhering to all safety guidelines, and utilizing all appropriate PPE
- Report all concerns, accidents and/or injuries to the VP of Operations and Human Resources Manager

- Provide information to customers on the care of shrubs, flowers, and plants
- Responsible for greenhouse cleanliness, organization and maintenance
