Use Restriction: Non-food use only. Not for use on vegetables, herbs or fruit bearing trees.

Use DeerPro® Spring/Summer Deer Repellent as a repellent to reduce browsing and chewing damage from deer, rabbits, and voles (*Microtus* spp.). Repellency results from the odor of treated plant parts. One application will protect treated plants from 3 – 6 weeks, depending on weather conditions. Treat before the expected time of animal damage.

Thoroughly shake DeerPro® Spring/Summer Deer Repellent prior to use. Mix one part of formulation with 7 parts of water. Shake or mix thoroughly. Use a hand or low-pressure power sprayer to give a heavy coating to flowers and foliage. Thoroughly cover treatment area to a point well above the reach of animals. To permit repellent film to properly set, apply under favorable drying conditions: 30 minutes before rain or watering, relative humidity below 70% and temperature above 40F.

Avoid overspray on house siding, patios and containers as product may cause staining.

Thoroughly flush sprayer screens and nozzles promptly following use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep Away from Children. Store in a cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
